Title : The Burning Bush



Exodus Chapter 3 : 1-17




Title : Palette

These bricks represent the strength of the promises my father made to us.




Title : Sands of Time

Title : The Horizon





(The words in Punjabi means I love you.)




Title : 5 Seconds to Sunrise

'5 Seconds to Sunrise' is my take on how awesome that moment could be.




Title : Sunset in Pontian

Title : Rhythm at Sunset



to my ears.




Title : 2 Become 1




Title : The Shoreline


Title : Hope
